The position is responsible for the daily operations of the after school program for students from Kindergarten through Middle School including: maintaining a positive classroom atmosphere, providing occasional help with homework, tending to behavioral issues when any arise, acting as liaison between parents and school staff, and traveling between campuses to support and facilitate the after school program. Experience working in a school setting is ideal.
