## **Custodian Porter**

This is an English language position; NO Chinese language proficiency required. Non-exempt, full-time position, 7:00 a.m.-3:30 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

#### **OPPORTUNITY**

We are seeking a dedicated and reliable School Custodian Porter to maintain the cleanliness, safety, and functionality of our school facilities. The ideal candidate will be responsible for performing a variety of custodial duties, ensuring a clean and sanitary environment for students, staff, and visitors. This role requires a strong attention to detail, the ability to work independently, and a commitment to upholding high standards of cleanliness and maintenance.

#### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES**

- Clean and sanitize common areas, including exterior litter pick, cleaning entryways and glass, multiple cleanings of student restrooms, auditorium cleaning, spill and carpet cleaning work, and cleaning of classrooms, common areas and other serviceable areas as assigned
- Use Janitorial cleaning equipment and chemicals as directed by management
- Buff and wax floors as needed and during deep cleaning
- Empty and clean waste receptacles and dispose of trash daily/as needed throughout the site
- Clean windows, glass partitions, and mirrors daily as needed
- Maintain and stock cleaning and maintenance supplies daily/as needed
- Monitor and report any maintenance or safety issues to the Facilities Management
- Follow all health and safety regulations and procedures per OSHA, CDE, San Francisco County Department of Health and other regulatory agencies
- Assist with moving of school materials and event set up
- Assist with special requests from school staff as assigned by Facilities Management
- Organize and maintain storage areas and janitor's closets, as assigned
- Assist with room setup and cleanup for school events and CAIS activities
- Fill out daily work reports and use of the CMMS work order system
- Assist with graffiti and homeless encampment cleanup on CAIS Campus
- Attend training sessions as required
- Respond to after-hours emergencies
- Other duties as assigned

- Three years janitorial experience
- Knowledge of green cleaning and sanitation procedures
- Ability to operate cleaning equipment and machines
- Physical stamina and the ability to lift heavy objects and perform repetitive tasks
- Strong attention to detail and thoroughness in completing tasks
- Effective communication skills and the ability to work effectively both independently and as part of a team

- Experience working in a school environment (preferred)
- Experience with CMMS systems (preferred)
